

# Point Count Form

**Instructions:** Point count duration is 5 minutes, split into a 3 minute segment followed by a 2 minute segment. During the first 3 minutes (Min 1-3) count all birds detected; during the last 2 minutes (Min 4-5) only count additional birds not detected in the previous 3 minutes. Record the highest level of breeding evidence (B.E.) observed. Don't forget to also count the number of red squirrels seen/heard.
