**BREEDING EVIDENCE (B.E) CODES**

<b>OBSERVED</b>	<b>A Agitated</b> behaviour or alarm call of an adult
<b>X</b> Observed but not in suitable nesting habitat	<b>B Brood patch</b> or cloacal protuberance on an adult
<b>POSSIBLE BREEDING</b>	<b>N Nest-building</b> by wrens or woodpeckers
<b>H</b> In suitable nesting <b>habitat</b> in breeding season	<b>CONFIRMED BREEDING</b>
<b>S</b> <b>Singing/calling/drumming</b> associated with breeding in nesting habitat in breeding season	<b>NB Nest building</b> , including carrying nesting material (except wrens and woodpeckers)
<b>PROBABLE BREEDING</b>	<b>DD Distraction display</b> , attempt to draw attention away from nest/young by feigning injury or other distraction
<b>M Multiple</b> (≥7) individuals singing/calling/drumming heard on the same date and in the same square	<b>NU Empty nest used</b> during atlas survey period, or identifiable egg shells
<b>P Pair</b> observed together in suitable nesting habitat	<b>FY Recently fledged</b> or downy <b>young</b> incapable of sustained flight
<b>T</b> Presumed <b>territory</b> = presence of an adult bird, at the same place, on ≥2 visits, one week or more apart	<b>AE Adult</b> occupying, leaving or <b>entering</b> a probable nest site or behaviour suggesting an occupied nest
<b>D Display</b> involving male & female (display, courtship feeding, copulation) or antagonistic behaviour between ≥2 individuals (territorial disputes or chases)	<b>FS</b> Adult carrying a <b>fecal sac</b>
<b>V Visiting</b> a probable nest site in suitable habitat	<b>CF</b> Adult <b>carrying food</b> for young
	<b>NE Nest</b> containing one or more <b>eggs</b>
	<b>NY Nest</b> with one or more <b>young</b> (seen or heard)
